AND UPON the Court being so satisfied,

IT IS DECLARED that the impugned decision was unlawful and in breach of Article 2 European Convention on Human Rights and thereby s. 6 of the Human Rights Act 1998 for the reasons set forth in the written Judgment of this Honourable Court.

AND IT IS ORDERED that;

- the decision made by the Respondent, be forthwith removed into the Queen's Bench Division here for the purpose of being quashed,
- 2. upon the said decision being removed into the Queen's Bench Division as aforesaid the same be quashed without further Order,
- 3. the said decision be remitted to the Respondent with a direction to reconsider it and reach a decision in accordance with the ruling of this Court;
 - "An Order of Mandamus to compel the Respondent to expeditiously honour its enforceable public commitment to provide an overarching report into the Glenanne group of cases and to do so in accordance with the necessary minimum elements

summarised at paragraphs 169-170 of the main Judgment",

4. the Respondent shall pay to the Applicant the costs of this application and the costs reserved by the Order dated 2 February 2015 such costs shall be taxed in default of agreement and;

5. the Applicant's costs be taxed in accordance with Schedule 2 to the Legal Aid, Advice and Assistance (Northern Ireland) Order 1981.
